How do we do it? By tackling systems of power and oppression and having strategies for change and resilience, and by having expertise in health systems, legal systems and the perinatal period.

Provide individual legal counseling for teen parents.

Create and participate in media related to the sociobiology of the perinatal period to advance birth justice.
