I at all costs wanted to make sure I had custody of my babies.

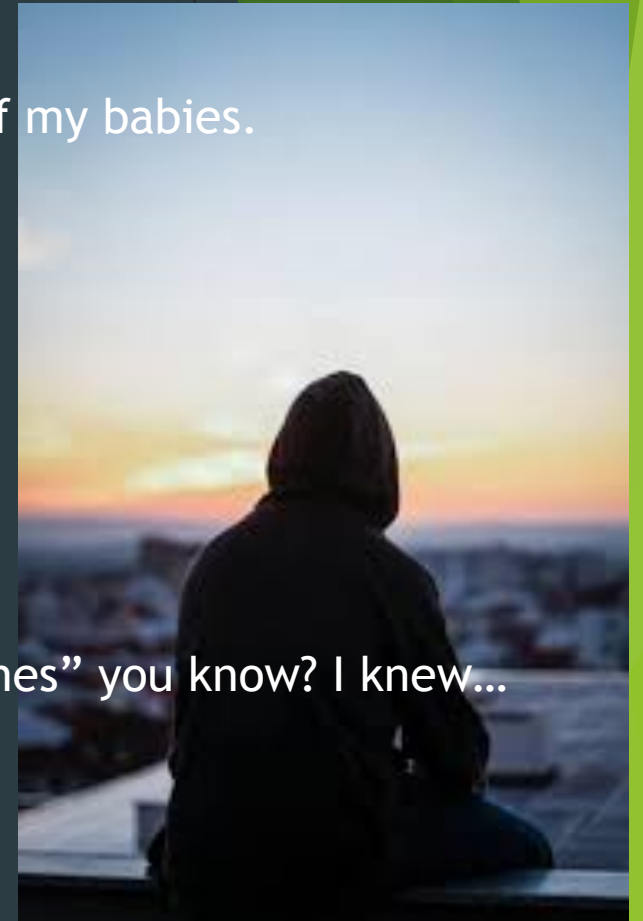
I was trusting in my own body.

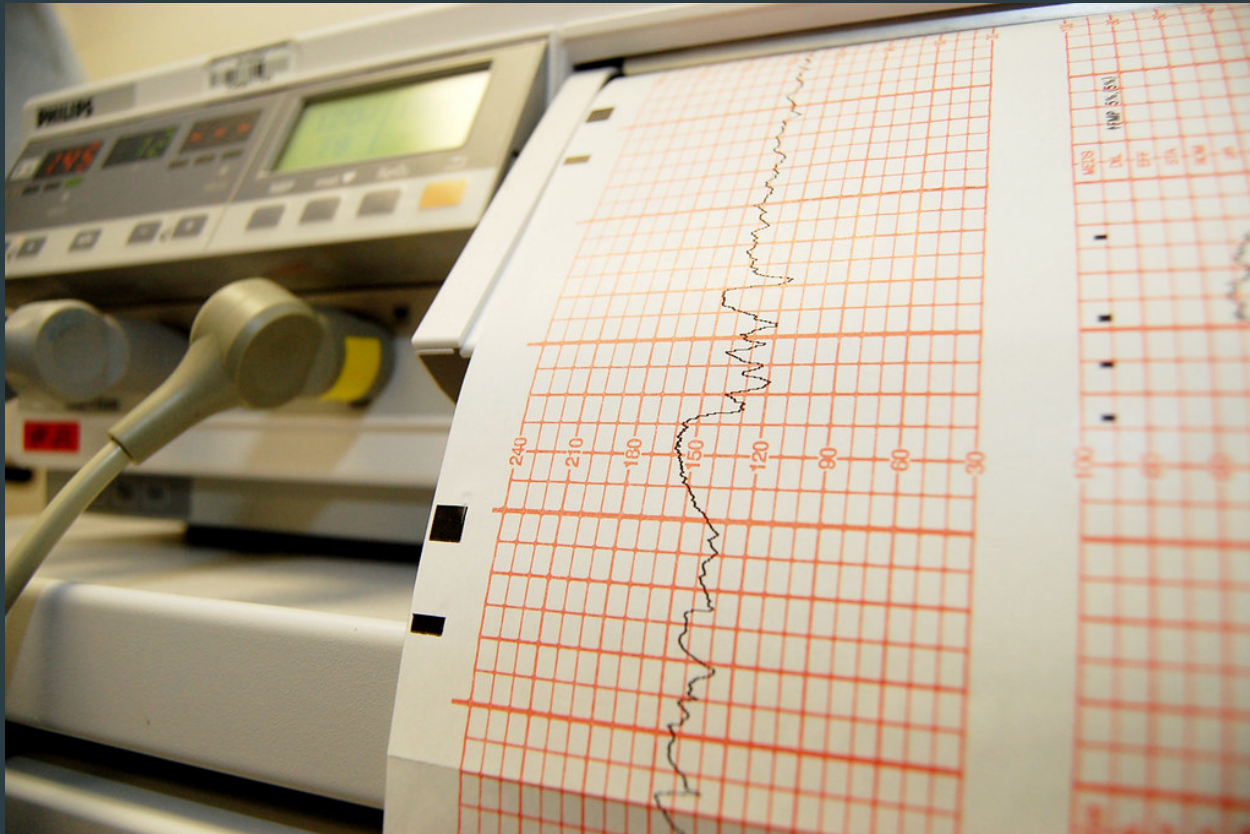

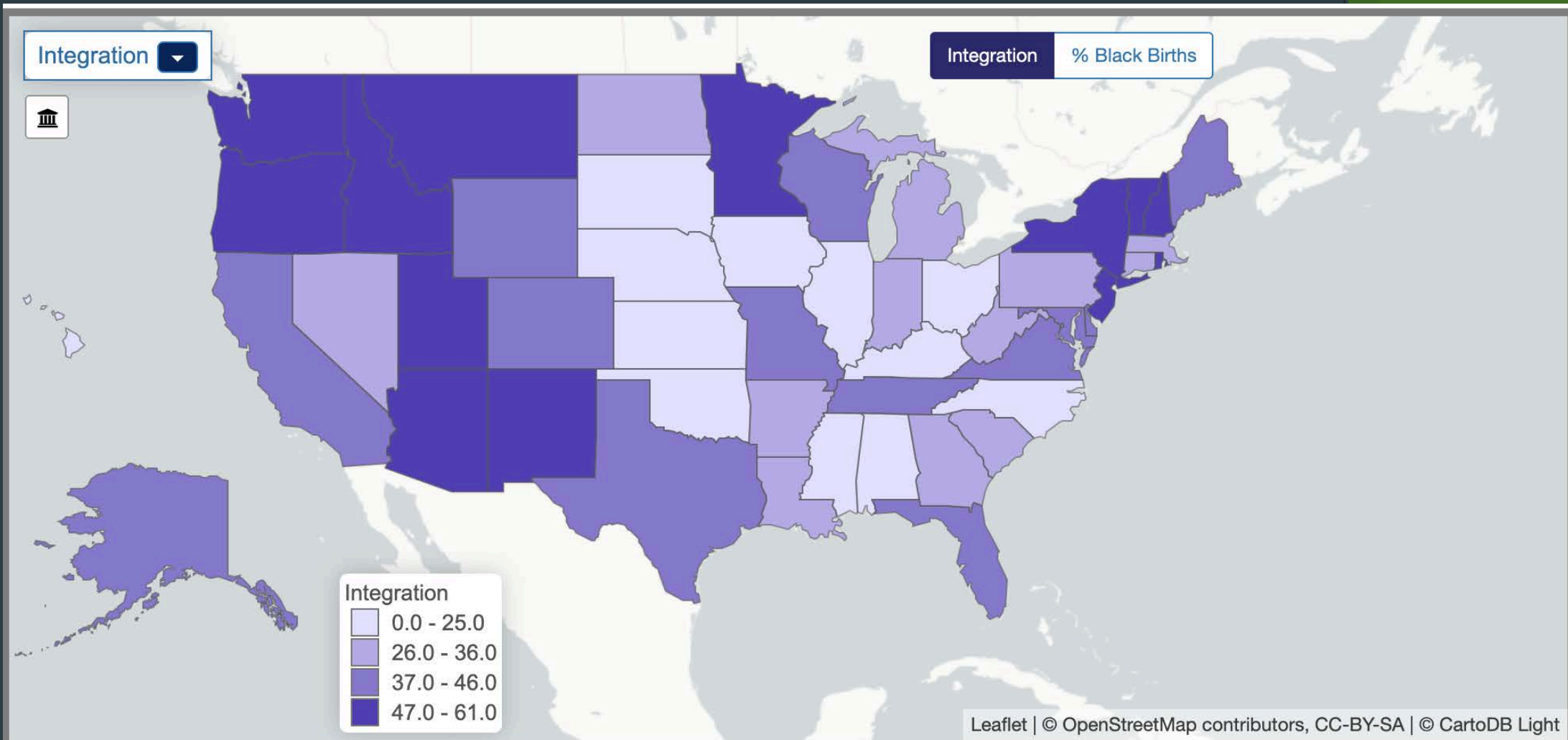
Junk Science: pregnancy in general



EFM for predicting cerebral palsy it has a false positive rate of 99.8%

EFM is used in 90% of pregnancies in the United States.

Continuous electronic fetal heart rate monitoring was introduced into hospitals in the 1970s without evidence from clinical trials, but with a strong marketing push from the monitoring industry

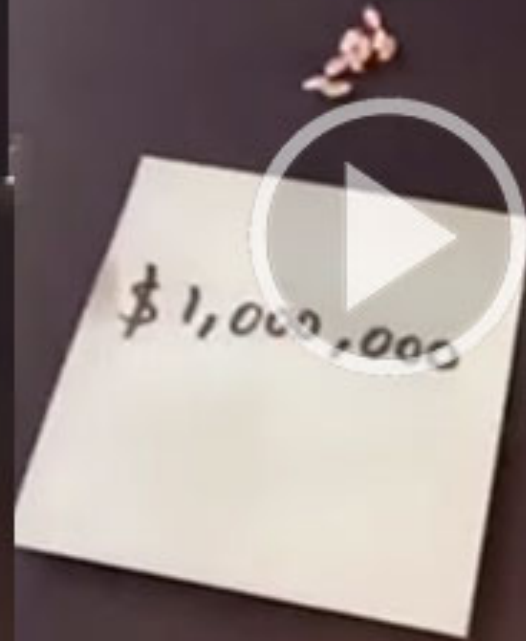

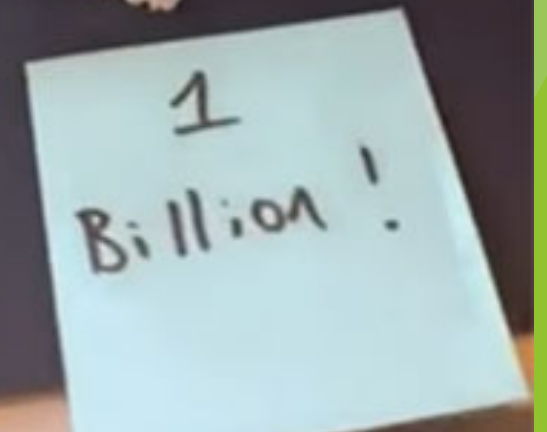

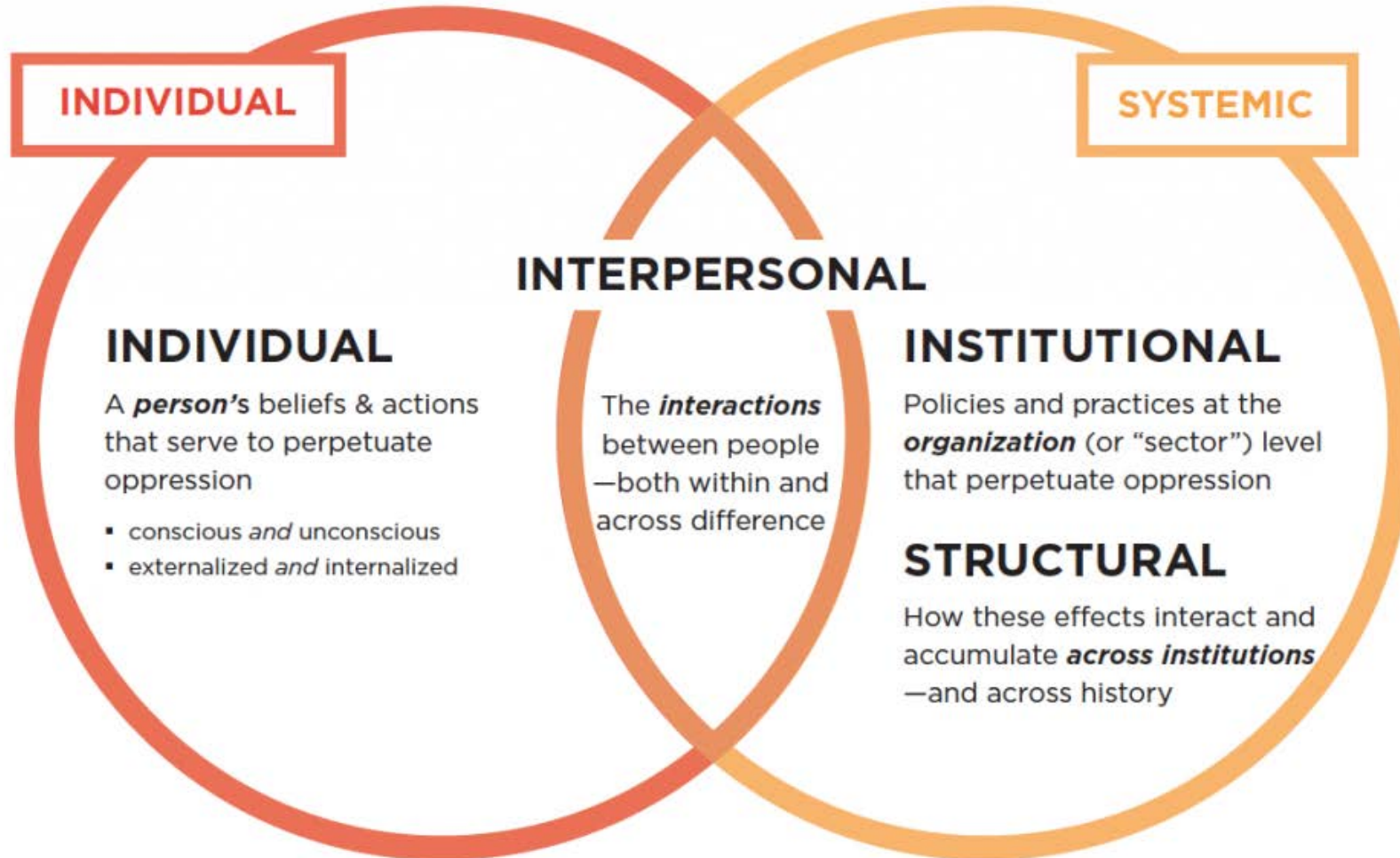
What is Reproductive Justice?



Reproductive Health	Reproductive Rights	Reproductive Justice
Sees the problem as a lack of access to health services, lack of information about health services, a lack of accurate health data	Sees the problem as a lack of legal protection or lack of laws protecting individual's rights.	Sees the problem as self-determination being limited by power inequities across multiple systems.

The Midwives Model of Care includes:

- ▶ Monitoring the physical, **psychological**, and **social well-being** of the mother throughout the childbearing cycle
- ▶ Providing the mother with **individualized** education, counseling, and prenatal care, continuous hands-on assistance during labor and delivery, and postpartum support
- ▶ Minimizing technological interventions
- ▶ Identifying and referring women who require obstetrical attention
